Dear Parents,

The school year is coming to an end and with it a lot of the academic work. We ended our units for language arts this week. We will continue to work with comprehension and writing during the following weeks. We are working on our last chapter for math, which has to do with geometry. We are also almost done with our learning on social studies. We still have some work to do during science time. Having said that, please understand that teaching will still go on and attendance and punctuality are imperative.

On Monday we honored our planet by watching a short clip about taking care of it, reading about Earth Day, and sharing and writing ideas about how the students can make a difference to protect our planet. We reviewed the three R's: Reuse, Recycle, and Reduce.

During social studies, we discussed services, goods, loans, how and why nations trade goods, needs and wants among other concepts about economics.

In language arts, we reviewed the controlled-r- syllables, metaphors, repeated lines, and rhyming words; using editing marks to correct any grammar mistakes, rereading, and looking for context clues to improve comprehension. This week we covered the genre of poetry, the students wrote a few wonderful poems this week; some students used repeated lines, some used rhyming words and others just verses.

During Spanish, we covered the letter Zz, words -hago (to do) and -ayudo (to help), and adjectives. The students practice reading simple sentences every week, we do the calendar (days, months, dates) and they count as well. The students also practice writing short sentences.
