This week the children learned under the topic; How are seasons different? The letters of the week were; Bb and Ll. They reviewed the sound for those two letters and wrote words like; bat, ball, baby, bug, lemon, let, let, and lion. The two new sight words were; little and is which they read, spelled, and wrote sentences with them. This week they read the story: "Is It Hot?". We read it as a group and then they took turns reading and they realized that there were no pictures in the sentences. They are working on reading without dragging the words and the sentences, please practice with them at home when reading the small book in their homework. It is important that at this time, they are able to read words without dragging them since we have gone over all sounds and have more learned vocabulary that they are using.

In Math we continued with the teen numbers. We worked on 16-19. Recognizing these numbers, writing them, and also ways on how to make them. They continued with the pattern; 10 ones and _____ ones for each number. We also wrote addition sentences for those numbers. For example: $16=10+6$ and so on.

Social studies this week was about remembering Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. They learned all about his life and why was he important to our history. The children read about him, saw a video about his life, and discussed his famous speech; "I Have a Dream". They also wrote about what was their dream to make their world a better place (school and their home). Dreams like; being a better friend at school, helping their pets, being better listeners at home and helping mom and dad.

On Tuesday we had a wonderful time on a field trip. We went to the clubhouse to listen and participate in songs and dancing with Mrs. Patty. The children had a great time and even learned a little sign language.
