Dear Parents,

This week, we are diving into the delightful world of the  Five Little Ducks  This classic nursery rhyme offers a fun and engaging way for our toddlers to learn about counting, animal sounds, and the concept of “going away and coming back.”

 Story Time:  We will read the “Five Little Ducks” book and sing the accompanying song together. This helps with language development and rhythm.

 Counting Games:  Using duck-shaped counters, the children will practice counting from 1 to 5, enhancing their early math skills.

 Arts and Crafts:  The children will create their own little duck puppets using paper, crayons, and other craft materials. This activity encourages creativity and fine motor skills.

 Outdoor Play  Weather permitting, we had a “duck parade” outside where the children waddle like ducks, and we practiced their gross motor skills.

 Water Play  We’ll set up a small water bin with floating ducks for sensory play, allowing the children to explore and have fun with water in a controlled environment.

 We encourage you to sing the “Five Little Ducks” song at home with your child and talk about the different activities they are participating in. This reinforces what they are learning and makes the experience even more enjoyable.

They engage in a creative painting activity, exploring colors and expressing themselves through vibrant brush strokes on a large sheet of paper.
