Dear Parents of Kindergarten Students;

I hope that you had a wonderful week!

This week in Kindergarten the children were busy learning.

In language arts we continued with our Start Smart Week 2. During this week we reviewed letters li-Pp. They practiced writing upper case and lower case, reviewed the sounds that each of these letters make, wrote words that begin with them and drew pictures for each word. We also went over words that rhyme by reminding them that words that rhyme have the same ending sound like; can-pan, house-mouse and hat-cat. On the big book of rhymes, they were able to count words by using their fingers to count as I read each word.

The new sight word was: "Can" and they spelled it, read it and wrote it in sentences about activities that they can do with their families.

On Friday each of them shared the pictures of "Who" is in their families and then we built our family wall.

In Social Studies we finished the unit by introducing the terms; past, present and future. They looked at pictures of the past and the present in their book and discussed the differences. We also read a story about bicycles and discussed how they were in the past, how they look in the present and predicted how they will look in the future.

During Math we began learning about the number 5. They learned how to write the number, the word to this number and also ways to represent the number. We used counters and cubes and drew sets of 5 objects to represent this number. The latter part of the week was spent learning ways to make 5 by using 2 different color counters on the 5 frame to make combinations.

Next week we are closed on Monday in observance of Labor Day.

Thursday there is an indoor field trip.

We will also have our first Math test, the day will be in the homework log.

The next two weeks the children will begin The National Geographic Science and we will be learning about day and night. So there will be no Social Studies.

Everyone got a sticker for completing homework this week.

Continue to read to your child and go over the sight words every day.
