This week was extraordinary! It was short but the children were busy learning about "Balls and Balloons".

For Circle Time, the children compared objects to circles and ovals. Some objects compared to a circle were a clock, a ball, and a drum. Objects compared to an oval were an egg, a foot ball, and a face. We sang "The Wheels On the Bus", "Rollie Pollie", and "5 Red Balloons".

For story time, we read the books "My First Book of Shapes", "Little Shape", "Shapes Everywhere In Nature", and "Crayola My First Book of Shapes".

For small group, the children got the opportunity to use crayons, Play-Doh, foam shapes, and dot to dot markers. The children made a sorting activity, by gluing foam circles and ovals to a piece of construction paper with the shapes of a circle and oval traced on them.

The children really enjoy the playground, but on Tuesday we had a rainy day. The rain did not stop us from having fun! We danced "Freeze Dance" and crawled through tunnels. Later in the week, the children played "Ring Around the Rosie", rode tricycles, and played with the balls.
