As we continue our theme of “Color, Shape and Size” this week, we learned about Shapes . The world is filled with amazing colors and shapes of all sizes. Over the next several weeks, children will be noticing and labeling the colors, shapes, and sizes of things around them. They will learn to sort and categorize objects by these attributes. Don’t be surprised when your child points to an object and describes it by its color, shape, and size: That button is a small, red circle.

 **Wonderful word of the week:** Star

 **Morning messages:** Shapes are everywhere, Some shapes have curvy lines, Squares are shapes with four sides, Flowers are my favorite shape and Lines and be straight or curvy .

 **Vocabulary learned:** circle, flower, heart, rectangle, shapes, star, square and triangle .

 **Literacy:** Finding shapes with Fernando and Colettes Cookies 

 **Art:** the children loved painting with different shapes as they were painting, they identified the shape and color. Making the circle shape using cups was a blast. They loved dipping their cup into paint and then onto construction paper. Making a robot using different shapes was another fun filled and learning art activity. The children were given different shapes, and they made a robot using the shapes.

 **Photo Activity Cards** that were shown to the children: flowers and hearts. The children enjoyed forming a heart using their index finger and thumbs and then they bent their index finger to make the top part of the heart 

 **Math :** Construction : the children sorted colored Legos by shape and then by colors .
