We want to wish our friend Bastian a happy 6th birthday!

Next week on Wednesday 10/26 is our Halloween event! Parents will be allowed to attend. Our parade time is at 12:15pm. We can't wait to see everyone in their costumes!

In language arts/reading our question of the week was "What kind of bugs do you know around you?" The vocabulary words were curious, observe, attaches, slender, and process. Our story of the week was "I Love Bugs!" The children really enjoyed this story because it had so many different bugs in it. They loved naming them! Our spelling and sight words of the week were all review words. The letters of the week were M, S, T, A, P. Students worked together to make words using those 5 letters like map, sat, and pat. Students worked in pairs to come up with sentences with their sight words. Next week we will start Unit 3 with new letters and sight words.

In math, we continued with Chapter 4. Students used 10 colored cubes to show different ways to make 10. The students also reviewed putting the numbers 0-10 in order and correctly identifying which numbers were missing. They played an exciting bean bag toss game where students threw the bean bag twice, made a matching cube train to the number, and compare if it was less or greater. We finished the week with some more hands-on games. The final game had students using the vocabulary words greater than, less than, and equal to. They each were able to compare the colored cubes they got. We are hoping to finish Chapter 4 next week.

In science this week, we continued with the night sky. We used the vocabulary words near and far. We compared a picture and noticed how things looked close and far from us. We discussed how things that are near may seem bigger than they actually are and how things that are far are the opposite. Then we named the different things we see in the night sky like the moon, stars, constellations, bats, and owls. We briefly went over how the moon may seem like it has light but it's actually the sun reflecting off the moon. We ended the week with a fun art activity for the sun and the moon.
