Dear Parents,

This week we traveled  to  Australia. During Circle Time we showed a picture of a kangaroo , Koala  and a platypus and we sang songs from Australia. We went over red, blue, and white. We worked on fine and gross motor skills. The children finger painted, colored freely with crayons and markers, and enjoyed painting . The children continue to practice their fine motor skills by doing fun art! They painted paper with red and blue paint. They also played with red Play Doh and puzzles  and are getting better at it. To practice their gross motor and fine motor skills the children played a marching game outside and also got to water paint which they enjoy with the teachers . Music class with Ms. Michelle was so much fun, the instrument of the day was the “El Wiro”. Each child got a chance to try it out on their own. 

Reminder:

Let's keep promoting independence in your child by letting them help you around the house (there are many things they can do if you let them), by allowing them to feed themselves (give them the spoon  and let them drink from a regular  cup), talk to them often, use words that are appropriate, don't use baby talk. You will see the difference.

Please remember to always bring an extra change of clothing for your child! The summer days are hot  and sometimes messy with outside activities and all, so please make sure that your child always has an extra little outfit in case of an accident. Make sure their clothing is appropriate for the heat;  don't bring too many long-sleeved shirts and pants! Please make sure that your child has an extra pair of socks  in the classroom.
