This week our theme was the Ocean. We discussed all the different kinds of animals and plants we can find such as: fishes, dolphins, turtles, shells, and seaweed. Then the students loved talking about going to the beach to swim in the ocean and build sandcastles. We also watched a video exploring the Coral Reef.

For our Art Activities, we made a fish, a jellyfish, a turtle, and a sailboat. A lot of our art activities needed popsicle sticks and construction paper. Then we read a bunch of stories such as: Pout Pout Fish, Not Norman, You Can Do It, House for Hermit Crab, and Shark Who Was Afraid of Everything.

Lastly, our STEM this week was Water Play. Each day the students completed 1-2 task cards where they had to build rafts, boats, or a pipe system, then had to test it out to see if they built it correctly or answered the question. With this STEM activity, the students learned new vocabulary words such as: prediction, float, sink, and weight. They loved playing with the water!!!
