The topic of this week was “FIVE SENSES” and the Letter was “Rr”. The students learned the concept of the 5 senses and learned how important these are. We explained to the children how the five senses help us figure out what's going on around us and help us decide whether to enjoy or not enjoy an experience: our eyes help us see, our ears let us hear, our hands help us feel, our noses let us smell, and our tongues help us taste things. The children had a fun activity where each of them got a chance to taste different flavors, smell a lotion, feel a sensory bin and see everything we had for the activity. We keep reviewing the weather, the days of the week, the months of the year, our morning songs, how they would like to be greeted when entering the classroom, and much more. ☺

STORY TIME: “Touch That!”, “Taste, Touch, See, Smell and Listening”, “Tastes Good”, “Hear This!”.

SOCCER: The kids are doing balance and coordination by following the instructions. After they finished, they got to kick the ball into the goal.

ART/SMALL GROUPS: When doing art, the kids made different activities such as; my book of five senses, Mr. Potato head 5 senses, tracing their own hand and adding different materials to feel on each finger. They used construction paper, glue, sticky eyes, cut out pictures of the 5 senses, and much more. We also did a five senses sorting activities where they had so much fun. We also played with Mr. Potato head during center time.

Music class was super fun in which the students got to play a drum and then sing “The Lion Speaks Tonight” with Mrs. Clarice. They named different wild animals while singing the song and we also listened to stories.

Science Lab is a great activity where the children get to engage with each other and teachers. They enjoy exploring around.
