The topic this week is wild animals. We reviewed our animals, the sounds they make, where they live, and what they eat. We showed each child a different animal and had them tell us what animals they hear. Parents, it is a good time to visit the zoo! The children will love it!

Circle Time/Music: Hello Everybody, Old Mac Donald Has a Zoo, 5 Little Monkeys Swinging On the Tree, The Elephant Moves Very Slowly, and Itsy Bitsy Spider. The children sing along to the songs, dance with their friends and teachers, and use different instruments.

Art/Small Group: We had the children paint with green paint on a small plate, then the teachers cut out a shape of a snake. We showed the children different animals that are green! The teachers cut and traced and the children glued the trunk and ears. Lastly, we divided the class and played with Play-Doh and plastic animals
