## A 2017 Marching Band Preview from the Directors

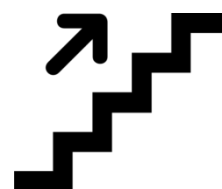
Dear Marching Band Students and Families,

## The Bands of Fall

For those new to Marching Band Season, here's a run down of the bands that make up the fall season...



- **RHS Marching Gaels:** Comprised solely of Roxbury High School Students grades 9-12, this is the competition marching band that will compete in local and regional band Invitionals from September to November.
- **Roxbury Sound:** This is RHS Football Band that plays at every home game in the stands during the game and during the halftime show. Band students from 8<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade comprise this band. You are not required to be in the Marching Gaels to participate in Roxbury Sound, and there are fewer practices than Marching Gaels.
- **Pep Band:** A smaller group of the Roxbury Sound members, this band travels to play at most away Football games during the season.
- **Color Guard:** Color Guard practice and compete as a unit along with the Marching Gaels in competition, and as members of the Roxbury Sound during home football games.

# THE BCB's-BAND CAMP BASICS

### Drop Off

Parents please be aware of the drop off and pick up policy. Students must be dropped off for camp in the parking lot across from the band room doors. Curb side drop offs are no longer permitted. Please drop them off 15-30 minutes BEFORE report time. Report time is when they are to be on the field.



### Pick Up

Pick up is now also in the parking lot across from the band room doors. Students are dismissed from the field within five minutes of the scheduled end time. Be prepared to wait up to 10-15 minutes for marchers to clean up and collect their things. If your student is in the percussion section, Color Guard, or a student leader it will take them a little longer as they have more equipment to put away. Also, as a courtesy to all, prompt pick-up is appreciated.

- Sunscreen, Bug Spray, Lip Balm, Hat, & Sunglasses
- Extra socks, shoes, clothes, and rain gear
- Large Strong plastic garbage bag for Equipment in case of rain

- Sandwich size bag for cell phone in case Of rain
- A Healthy LUNCH (for all day rehearsals)

So do you think being in band is easy? For the most part yes. But as you can imagine, keeping the show moving from week to week is quite a large task. It is only possible with the help and assistance from many parent volunteers. As in years past, this year your kids will have great opportunities to play in a multitude of venues, such as The Yamaha Cup in MetLife Stadium, The State Championship at Rutgers Stadium and the NJ Regional Championship in Old Bridge NJ. The Marching Band Logistics Team (Road Crew) helps the Marching Band by transporting equipment and props to and from the venues, as well as setting up the props and helping your kids get the equipment on the field prior to, and off the field after the performance. Under the lights, on Friday nights, the Roxbury Sound performs at all home football games.
