Our goal is to be able to provide a new pair of sox to every homeless person in Morris County, New Jersey to provide comfort and show love to those going through a difficult time in their life.

WHY WE STARTED SOX IN A BOX

Homeless people walk a lot during the day because they do not have a place to stay and they often do not have a good pair of sox. Rain-soaked feet (often in ill-fitting shoes), constant standing and diseases like diabetes take their toll on the feet of homeless people.

Clean sox are needed for homeless health care. They can make a real difference.

HERE IS HOW YOU CAN HELP

All you have to do is put some new sox in the box.

Or you can contact us at the e-mail address below and we will come to your house to pick up your donated sox for women, men or children.

The sox will be distributed on Saturday, December 2 to homeless individuals at shelters, soup kitchens and areas where the homeless often sleep outdoors.
