

College Hills Family,

Thank you for your recent input concerning our return to worship gatherings on June 7th. Below you can read what to expect from us and what we are encouraging you to do on that day.

What can I expect to experience if I come to the College Hills campus June 7th?

- ***A clean facility.*** We will thoroughly clean and disinfect the trafficked parts of our building before, in between, and after our services. We will have hand sanitizing stations at each entrance as you enter the building.
- ***A 50-minute worship service at 8 and 10 am.*** The services will be identical in style and substance. There will be some modifications due to the caution we want to exercise at this time. Examples include: we will use individual communion packs and not pass trays. Giving baskets will be placed throughout the worship center.
- ***A modified seating arrangement marked-off in the worship center.*** We are going to honor social distancing during worship by limiting the number of pews available. Families can sit together. Ushers will be available to help you find seats.
- ***A limit on extra traffic through the building.*** Only the worship center will be open. We will only open our two main lobby entrances. Coffee & food will not be available.

What can I do to help the experience of others if I come to the College Hills campus June 7th?

- ***Be gracious and considerate to others.*** Our highest priority is we ALL seek to love God through loving our neighbors on Sunday morning.
- ***Please wear a facemask.*** We encourage and recommend, though are not requiring, the use of facemasks on Sunday mornings for the sake of those around us.
- ***Honor social distancing.*** We encourage and recommend honoring six feet of distance while moving through the building and in between seated family units on the pews.
- ***Practice cleanliness.*** Covering sneezes and coughs, thoroughly washing your hands, and staying home when you feel sick are a few of the CDC recommendations we encourage.

What if I am not yet ready or able to come to the College Hills Campus for worship?

- ***That's okay.*** We want people to return when they feel most comfortable. We completely support those who are not yet ready to attend large gatherings.
- ***We are going to continue to offer online streaming service at 10 am.*** This service will be recorded and available online in case you cannot participate online at 10 am.
- ***We will also continue to offer a sermon on 98.9 WANT FM at both 8:00 and 10:30 am.***

Please reach out if you have any more questions. In the meantime, continue to pray for our leadership and church as we navigate these new waters together as faithfully as possible. We will continue to communicate any adjustments or expectations that change in the future.
