

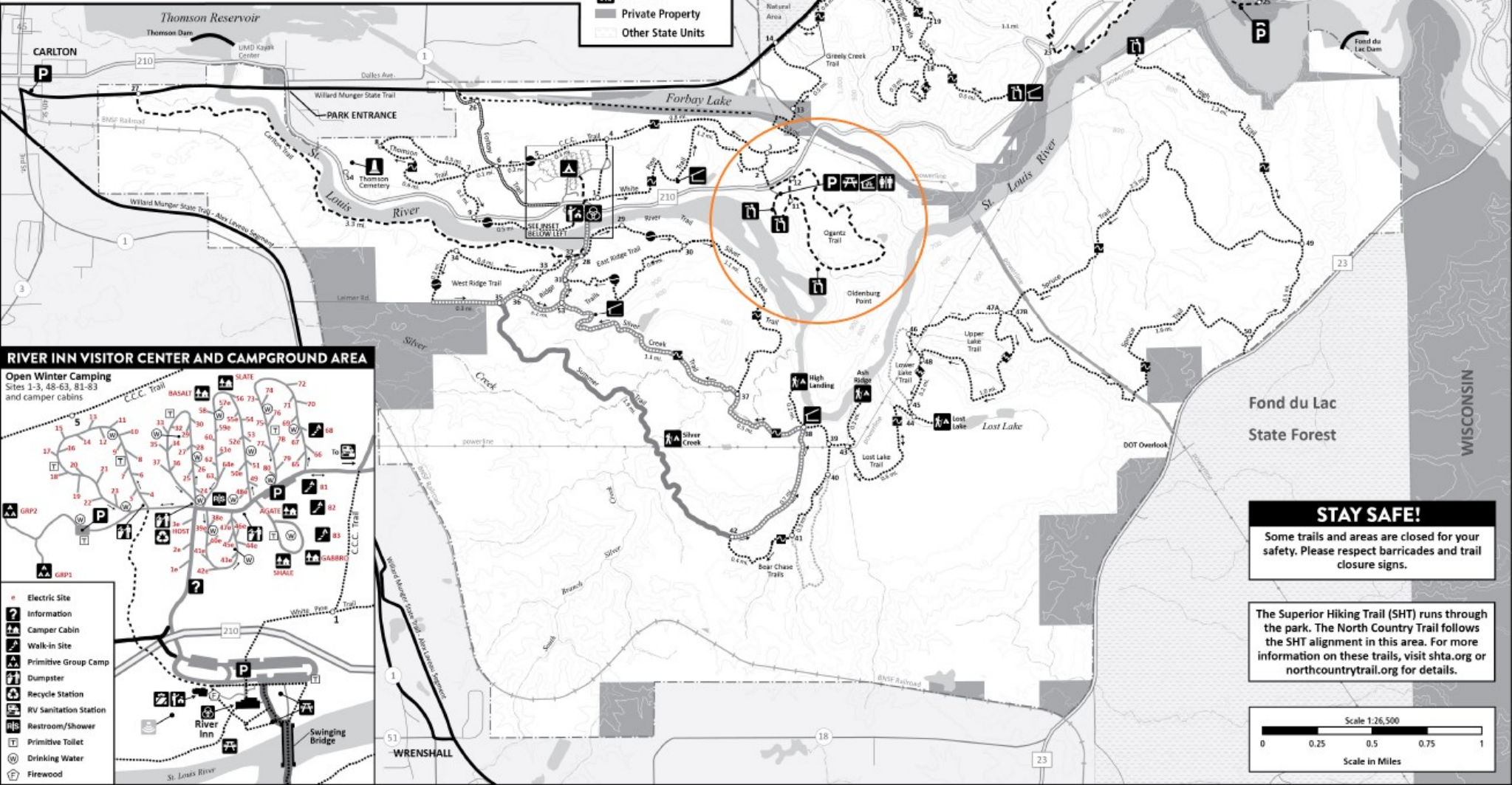
JAY COOKE STATE PARK - WINTER MAP

- Trails Closed (due to post-flood conditions)

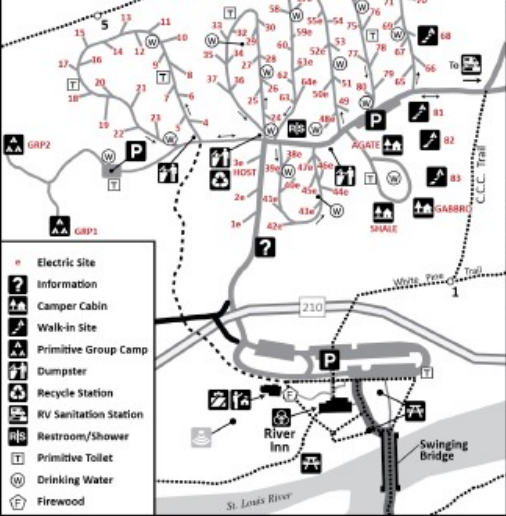
