

Message on behalf of Judge Kelli Wolk:

Please mail in any pleadings you wish to file with us and call with any questions we might be able to address from a safe distance. But as of Monday 5/18, the Estates Division is accepting in-person pleadings **by appointment only**. This is to allow us to ensure social distancing. Please review our website for how to make an appointment for different processes (i.e. oaths vs. filings vs. license applications.) Please adhere to Chief Judge Green's Order regarding masks and other safety precautions (Mask or face covering required. Everyone coming to the courthouses shall have a mask or face covering on to enter the building. The mask or face covering shall remain on while in the courthouse, unless you are given permission to remove the mask or face covering by the judge or other court staff member.)

Please ensure that you **have your forms completed**, and that you have all supporting documents prior to scheduling your appointment. You may continue to schedule virtual oaths, provided a Final Order has been entered, by emailing the general mailbox. At this time, we are not accepting appointments for our Compliance Department; please continue to mail these completed forms to our office (or drop them in the drop box located in the lobby of the Estates Division.)

We will continue to try to discuss questions by phone from outside of our office (to limit your exposure to the lobby and court personnel exposure to you.) Please see our court directory available on our website.
