

**APPLICATIONS FOR 2018
SEMINARY SCHOLARSHIP
DUE BY May 18, 2018**

QUALIFICATIONS:

The scholarship is to be awarded annually to one or more persons enrolled in a seminary accredited by the United Methodist Church, who is preparing for service as an ordained minister, a Minister of Christian Education, or Director of Christian Education. The award will be given in addition to scholarships awarded by the Upper New York Conference Board of Ordained Ministry. A person may receive the scholarship more than once.

APPLICATION:

Application for the scholarship is to be made to the Seminary Scholarship Committee, JUMC, PO Box 916, Jordan, NY 13080 or by e-mail to jordanumc1@gmail.com with "Seminary Scholarship Application" in the subject line.

AWARD:

The scholarship committee, in determining the award, is to give preference to applicants using the following order:

1. A member of the Jordan United Methodist Church.
2. A member of a church in the Crossroads District.
3. A member of a church in the Upper New York Conference.

The 2017 award will be governed by a number of factors including the financial need shown, and the number of credits being taken in the current academic year.

DEADLINE:

Applications must be received on or before May 18, 2018.
