
BULLET JOURNAL SPREAD

MUSIC MAYHEM SPREAD

You can make this tracker on printer paper or in a spare notebook if you have one. This week I made my spread on tan sketchbook paper and included some gel pen tips for colored paper!

This week you can celebrate music you love, what's been on repeat, or include last week's Camp Korey music challenge in your bullet journal.

1. To start I wrote the title at the top. I made two versions of this spread one which would be a monthly "what I've been listening to" style spread, and one which is the 5 prompts from CK's instagram challenge.



2. Then you want to draw rectangles below the heading. Decide how many songs you want and do that many rectangles. If you want to include more songs than I

did, you could do two rectangles next to each other instead of one all the way across the paper.

3. I freehanded these boxes so it would look a little more hand drawn and then added a shadow to the top and side of the boxes. The step by step is below:



4. The square on the left side of the rectangle is my “album cover” in the below “Camp Challenge” I drew minimalist versions of the song’s album covers. Above in “May Playlist” I drew an image that represented the title of the song. You could also print the album cover if you wanted to! Get creative!
