LET'S GET STARTED!

Composting happens when organic matter such as coffee grounds, vegetable peels, apple cores, eggshells, and even paper towels, decompose until they turn into a soil-like state, which can then return valuable nutrients to the soil and help maintain soil quality.

WHAT'S KIDS THAT COMPOST?

Kids That Compost (KTC) is a grass roots collective of kids, advocates, service providers, city leaders and schools working to divert household food waste away from landfills by building an innovative, high impact, scalable approach to composting.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

For just \$20 a month you can make a difference. Simply visit KidsThatCompost.org and sign up for our curbside pickup at the bottom of the page. Your KTC representative will deliver the KTC compost bucket and compostable liner to you within 5-7 business days. If you're already composting at home, great work! If you want to do more, we can also take leftover meat, fish, bones and dairy, which you will not want to add to your outdoor compost bin.
