Dear Lower School Parents,

It was great to see so many of you attend during Parent/Teacher Conferences. Students in grades one and two will be bringing home their first quarter reports this week. Reminders:

- The ECC is a peanut and tree nut free building. Please do not send items to school that contain nuts or are processed in a facility where nuts are used in production. - Hoping to see other grades join second grade with 100% participation in OUR Annual Fund.
- For Halloween day, all Lower School students may wear a Halloween costume to school. Children who arrive in a costume that may be too hot as the day continues should have appropriate clothing on underneath the costume in the event that they need to remove any part of their attire during the day. Lower School students will parade around campus shortly after arrival (approximately 8:15) to share their excitement with other divisions of the school.
