### WHAT WE LEARNED IN JANUARY

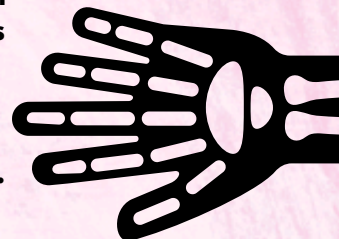
