As we move through this transition, we will implement a temporary organizational strategy to bridge the functionality of the Operations & Advancement areas with other divisions on campus until a more permanent structure can be developed. Right now, Cabinet and I are evaluating the current organizational structure to identify how the areas within Operations & Advancement might align with other areas and divisions within the University. At this time, I am not planning on hiring for the role of Vice President of Operations & Advancement in its current form.

We will be analyzing potential synergies and complements as part of this process. This is not a complete restructuring exercise of the University. However, there may be some adjustments

within the current structure. In the interim, I want to inform you of the temporary distribution of responsibilities as part of this "bridge" strategy. These include:

- Mr. Garrison Ortiz will manage Auxiliary Services & Facilities Operations
- Dr. Kristyn White Davis will manage Marketing & Communications
- Dr. Gail Mackin will manage Advancement
- Dr. Marie Humphrey will manage HSI & DEI Initiatives
- President Valdez will manage VISION 2028

Again, this is only a transition/bridge strategy. This distribution may not remain in this temporary reporting structure. The intent is to have a more permanent reporting structure in place by July 1, 2024, and to be fully implemented by the start of the Fall 2024 semester. I welcome any feedback or suggestions you may want to share with me.
