Re: 2020 Temporary Patio Expansion Street Use Permit

This communication is to provide you with an update on street use permit permissions for your respective temporary patio expansion that was originally permitted until October 1, 2020. As you may have seen on another update for this program, we will be extending this program until the beginning of the City of Calgary's Snow and Ice Control (SNIC) program. When winter maintenance operations likely resume in October, The City of Calgary will require the right-of-way that is currently being used for temporary sidewalks adjacent to patios on public lands to provide winter operation services. You will be notified in advance of the conclusion of this program; however, the actual date will be weather dependent as we realize patios are an important part of your business and we want to support them as long as possible.

With respect to permits that are set to expire on October 1, 2020, your current permit(s) will be valid until the end date of this program and no new permit will be sent to you. This letter will also serve as proof of extension. We will inform Calgary Community Standards and City Bylaw services of the extension but in the event you receive inquiries about a permit extension, please provide this letter.

Please also note that any lane closures will conclude when the program ends and all temporary traffic control materials will be removed.
