

## City seeks input with stormwater survey

### Submitted Content

The Norman City Council is seeking input on a proposed stormwater bond and utility fee to address water quality protection and flood prevention needs.

This is in response to concerns residents have expressed about the impact flooding has on public safety and property values, as well as some federal mandates the city must meet to reduce stormwater pollution in Norman's streams, rivers and lakes.

Flooding and water pollution are issues that affect all of Norman's wards.

In April, the Norman Stormwater Citizen Committee was formed to develop a citizen-based solution.

The committee met every two weeks for a year to learn about stormwater problems in Norman and to develop options to fund the solutions to address flooding and water pollution issues across Norman.
