

Norman proclaims November as Veterans Month

Norman Mayor Lynne Miller has proclaimed November as Veterans Month as the city plans the upcoming 2018 Veterans Day Parade and Memorial Ceremony.

The Nov. 11 events are themed “Honor to Serve.”

A parade will travel from the Stephenson Research Center north on Jenkins Avenue to Reaves Park to kick off festivities at 1:30 p.m.

Immediately following, a 2:30 p.m. memorial ceremony will be led by Maj. Gen. Rita Aragon with keynote speaker Brig. Gen. Paul D. Costilow at the Cleveland County Veterans Memorial in Reaves Park, 2501 S Jenkins Ave.

In addition to light refreshments, ceremony attendees will be able to view static displays of military vehicles, an Oklahoma Highway Patrol helicopter, a Chinook helicopter and nearly 25 classic cars from the Canadian River Cruisers.
