Juvenile Charged with Agg UUW + Agg Discharge of Firearm



Offender: Male juvenile, 17

Charges: One (1) felony count – Agg UUW/Person/<21
One (1) felony count – Poss Firearm W/ Defaced Serial Number
One (1) felony count – Agg Discharge of Firearm

Court: Juvenile Court – 1100 S. Hamilton – June 2, 2021

Narrative: On June 1, 2021, at approx. 7:30 p.m. officers responded to a call of shots fired call near Oz Park in the 2000 block of N. Burling St. (18th District, Area 3). Officers discovered that the above male juvenile offender shot into a crowd of people, causing a graze wound to a 17-year-old male victim. The offender was located nearby and placed into custody without incident in the 900 block of W. Armitage Ave. A Smith & Wesson handgun was recovered. Later that day the offender was charged with Aggravated UUW and Possession of a Firearm. On the morning of June 8, charges were amended to include the addition of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm. The latest charge resulted from additional video evidence submitted to the State's Attorney's Office by Area 3 Detectives. No additional information is available at this time.
