In Dr. Knight's words, "Of all species, only humans have the innate drive to leave a legacy, a testament that we existed. Be it the Pyramids of Giza, writing in sand script, or cave carvings, we innately leave a trail of unbroken statements: 'we were here and are no more, but live in our creations.' My photos, all of which line the walls of Illinois Central track embankments and backstreets (alleys) across Chicago, do the same."

The reception will begin with a 30-minute period for mingling, with light refreshments. A 60-minute talk by Dr. Knight about the exhibit will begin at 2:30 p.m.

Legacy of Our Ancestors, showcasing 12 images taken by Dr. Knight, will be on display at the Lincoln Park Branch from **July 22 - August 26, 2017**.
