## Quality Program or Agency - Organizational Award

Submission due: August 14, 2024

### Criteria

The nomination may recognize an accomplishment in any area of training, organizational development, or workforce development, (i.e. presentation methods, curriculum development, transfer of learning, adult learning methodology, training management, or evaluation).

The nomination should meet one of the following criteria:

- The successful development and implementation of a cutting edge, innovative approach or a variation of a traditional process, procedure, or practice in a specific area that improves the quality of services offered in a public human service agency
- The successful development and implementation of a cutting edge, innovative approach, or a variation of a traditional process, procedure or practice in a comprehensive program that improves the quality of services offered in a public human service agency
- A creative management practice that improves performance, advances the profession, and/or promotes better understanding of a human services agency.

### Additional Criteria:

1. The nomination activities must have occurred in the last three years.
2. The nomination must have been developed for a public human services agency.
3. The nomination may have been developed by an individual or multiple parties.
4. Individuals may submit nominations in which they have direct involvement.
5. NSDTA Executive Advisory Council member(s) may submit nominations in which they have direct involvement.
