Introduction to the Emerging Leader Program

In 2016, APHSA, in partnership with the Human Services Information Technology Advisory Group (HSITAG), started the APHSA Emerging Leaders Program. The goal of the Program is to promote and strengthen collaboration among health and human services and IT professionals through:

- Improving Leadership Skills
- Enriching Networking Acumen
- Enhancing Presentation Abilities

Overview of the Emerging Leader Program

Each year the cohort class is comprised of approximately 30 nominated junior and mid-level professionals from state and local government and private sector who are on track for senior leadership roles in the next 3-5 years of their career. In addition to attending the conference, Emerging Leaders engage in a tailored experience including:

- Closed sessions with keynote speakers
- Private networking reception
- Curated sessions with industry leaders
- Opportunity to showcase their own leadership journey
- Special recognition at the conference

Fellowship Opportunity

State and local government employees selected for the Emerging Leader Program will have the opportunity to apply for ISM Fellowships. ISM Fellowships offer travel assistance for state and local government individuals to attend the 2023 ISM + PHSA Education Conference & Expo. These ISM Fellowships are intended to help ensure that the Emerging Leader Program is accessible to nominated and selected individuals that would not be able to participate due to budget restrictions within their agency of employment.

Application

We are now accepting nominations for the 2023 APHSA Emerging Leader Program. Please consider nominating an up-and-coming leader within your organization for this opportunity. Nominations will close on June 7, 2023. You can complete the application here.

Nominee Criteria

Nominees should meet all or most of the following criteria:

- Demonstrated high performance over a sustained period
- Seen as a future business or technology leader within the organization
- Likely to assume a leadership role within the next 3-5 years
- 5+ years of experience preferred¹

¹ 5+ years in a junior/mid-level position on track to a leadership role

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Nomination and Selection Process

Each state and local dues-paying member agency and each sponsoring organization will be eligible to nominate one individual. No more than 30 individuals will be selected. The goal is to have a balance between industry and government participation. Organizations must coordinate and may not submit more than one nominee.

Acknowledgements and Agreements - Public Sector

Travel Acknowledgements - Public Sector
