Career Achievement - an Individual Award

Submission due: August 14, 2024

Criteria:

1. Demonstrated throughout his/her career a commitment to the profession of human services training, organizational development, workforce development and/or staff development; and/or significant contributions to the profession in terms of leadership, new ideas, or education. As measured by improved agency outcomes, impact on human services training, or improvement in best practices at a local, state or national level; and/or service in a variety of leadership roles; and/or excellence and professionalism in the human services sector.
2. Individuals who have contributed to the profession in any training, organizational development, workforce development or management position may be nominated for this award.
3. The nomination packet should include documentation of the person's impact within human services training and/or organizational or workforce development for public sector human services agencies. Evaluation, cost savings, advancement of agency outcomes documentation, if applicable, should be included in the nomination packet.
4. NSDTA Executive Advisory Council members may not be nominated.

As some nominees may qualify for both Career Achievement and Distinguished Service in Training awards, you may indicate on the Nomination Form that you wish for an individual to be considered for both awards. You only need to submit one nomination packet. Be sure to address ALL the criteria listed for both awards.
