Technology Innovation Award- an Organizational Award

Submission Due: August 14, 2024

Criteria

The nomination may recognize an accomplishment in any area of training, organizational development or workforce development where technology was used to develop or create a product or program to support or elevate the quality of services offered in a public human service agency. (i.e. Virtual Learning, Hybrid Learning, Simulations, Podcast Series, Video Series, Just In Time Learning, Virtual Onboarding, etc.)

The nomination should meet at least one criteria listed below:

- The successful development and implementation using a form of technology to create a cutting edge, innovative approach or a variation of a traditional process, procedure, or practice in a specific area that improves the quality of services offered in a public human service agency
- The successful development and implementation using a form of technology to create a cutting edge, innovative approach, or a variation of a traditional process, procedure or practice in a comprehensive program that improves the quality of services offered in a public human service agency
- A creative management practice using a form of technology that improves performance, advances the profession, and/or promotes better understanding of a human services agency.

The following additional criteria must be met:

1. The nomination activities must have occurred in the last three years.
2. The nomination activities must have been developed for a public human services agency.
3. Individuals may submit nominations in which they have direct involvement.

4. NSDTA Executive Advisory Council member(s) may submit nominations in which they have direct involvement.

2. In addition to the electronic Nomination Form, you may submit the following information via email:

- Abstract to demonstrate how the program /agency meets the award criteria. (DROP Up to 2 Pages) This supports the overview of contributions listed above.
- Additional Supporting Information

The committee does not accept complete copies of curriculum, full program descriptions or Level 1 evaluations as part of the supporting materials.

Award winners will be honored at the NSTDA Annual Education Conference in Albuquerque, New Mexico on October 20-23, 2024.

No travel costs or per diem expenses will be paid by NSDTA for the Quality, Distinguished Service in Training, Technology Innovation or Career Achievement Award winners.
