



## Pastor's Page



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we all know, in recent months a number of unmarked graves of children belonging to the First Nation tribes in Canada—those we would refer to as Native Americans in the United States—were found at sites where residential schools existed that were owned and operated by the Catholic Church. The initial discoveries have led to numerous other diggings and disclosures that brought to light a pattern that appears to be far more widespread and endemic, and this has also prompted a closer examination of the history, interaction and relations the Catholic Church has had with Native American tribes in the USA.

Here at OLG, while the picture and the story are a long way from attaining full clarity, we have come to understand that our parish grounds used to be a site that was—and perhaps still is—sacred to the Duwamish Native American people. Located as we are at the summit of the highest portion in the West Seattle region—hence the name, “Highpoint”—we have learned that the land we now occupy may have had, historically at least, great significance to the Duwamish tribe. We are presently trying to learn more about this matter, and to make contact with representatives of the Duwamish people, so that we might find a way to prayerfully, publicly and respectfully recognize and honor this reality. Stay tuned, please, for more details as they become available.

I will be away from the parish and my usual pastoral duties for the next couple of weeks. I will be flying down to California to join many of my long-time friends and former classmates for the reunion marking the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of our graduation from Branham Public High School in San Jose, California. Go Bruins!!

Alas, this means, sadly for me, that I will have to miss the OLG Parish Picnic on Friday, August 27<sup>th</sup>—the same date of my high school reunion—and the Loop the ‘Lupe 5-K Fun Run/Walk and Obstacle Course on Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup>. I nonetheless wish to thank all those whose time, energy and talent have gone into the planning, preparations and putting on of these two important events. In a host of ways these activities will benefit and bring enjoyment to so many and will enable participants to experience the wonderful spirit of involvement and outreach that is such a blessing both to those who give to it and to those who receive from it. My sincerest thanks to all contributors and participants.

I will be returning to Seattle and to OLG in time for our Masses for the 23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time—September 4<sup>th</sup>/5<sup>th</sup>. Please be assured that you will be in my prayers the whole time I am away. A safe and enjoyable summer’s end to all.

### Urge President Biden to End the Death Penalty




