

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Now that the Called to Serve as Christ Campaign (CSCC) has begun at OLG, I wish as your pastor to once again express my strong and sincere support for this Archdiocesan-wide effort to ensure the long-term sufficiency of the pension and health care needs of our retired priests and vowed religious women. These men and women have served the parishes, schools, hospitals and ministries of Western Washington in so many ways and for so many years. Our generous support for the CSCC is a sign of our gratitude for the generous and long-standing service these priests and sisters have given to the people of God in this Archdiocese. Our parish's goal for the CSCC is just under \$850,000. Given the long history of generous giving here at OLG, this amount is a very attainable goal, especially considering that the pledges are meant to be given over a three-year period. Remember too that 15% of every dollar donated to the CSCC will come back to OLG to strengthen the life and ministries of our parish community. For all of these reasons, I ask each and every household at OLG to please make a meaningful and generous gift to the CSCC. Jack will be offering his own encouragement and support for the CSCC from the perspective of a retired priest who has served the Archdiocese of Seattle for over 40 years! I know you will welcome him with loving enthusiasm, and that you will be blessed once again by his priestly leadership of prayer and by his preaching.
