Over the last few months, 10 families from Nicaragua have arrived in West Seattle seeking asylum. Many of the families are currently living together and as apartments open, we have helped them with rent and furniture to get them started. In fact, thanks to the generosity of so many in our community, our Vincentians, along with the West Seattle Interfaith Network, have been able to provide all the families with furniture for their apartments. We have also given each family a voucher for the St. Vincent de Paul thrift store to help get them set up in their homes.
