5-2-19 What a Disaster! We will be learning about infamous disasters like the Titanic and Pompeii. We will be learning about these through books, videos and even experiments.


5-9-19 Mother's Day Craft: Tea Cup Card



Ruth Arizona Allen Born: 2 May 1874 Bergman, Boone County, AR

Death: January 1971 Harrison, Boone County, Arkansas

Parents: Dallas and Elvira (Rose) Lovett

Spouse: Lewis Franklyn Allen married: 16 November 1890

Children: Floyd, Roy, Aaron, Arch, _____, and Edna

Religion: First Christian Church baptized in Crooked Creek at age 14.

Allen was Boone County's first Gold Star Mother of World War 1. Her son Roy died in the Battle of Argonne in October of 1918. American Gold Star Mothers is an organization of American mothers who lost their sons or daughters while performing military duties during war time.

Allen was a petite woman who in 1954 at age 80 mowed her lawn, did all her and son Floyd's cooking, cleaning and laundry. She gave praise to the Lord and Dr. Ross Fowler for her good health. She out lived her husband and five of their six children.
