Today, Christ is still at work through the church.

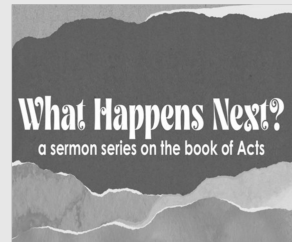
