BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE

The closing date for our term loan and start of construction are in sight! We are now looking at the 2nd week of July for closing to be complete and construction to start. As soon as the date for demolition is set we will send out a notice and ask for volunteers. This light interior demo sweat equity saves \$20,100 for the project. Staff and volunteers have been working hard these past weeks to empty all the spaces that will be impacted by construction. Special thanks goes to the Hard Hats for their work this past Wednesday to help staff relocate to temporary shared office spaces. With the emptying of many rooms we brought a storage container on site. It was necessary to place it in the special needs parking lot, thus taking up several of those needed spots. If you need the special needs parking lot, please know there is still plenty of space for you. If, however, you are able to park in the main lot we do appreciate that, leaving the spaces for those with mobility issues. Many thanks for your caring for one another in this community!



SPECIAL OFFERING OPPORTUNITY

The Minneapolis Area Synod invites all 137 worshipping communities in the Synod to participate in an initiative to raise funds for our immigrant neighbors. Congregations working with immigrant communities can apply for grants for mutual aid, training and education, and advocacy efforts. So far, the Welcome Fund has raised more than \$270,000 and distributed more than \$200,000 in just five months. But the need is still great. The Synod goal is to raise an extra \$50,000 for the Welcome Fund during the month of June. OSLC FINANCE UPDATE

We are well on our way to the dog days of summer with all of the heat, humidity and storms we've weathered already. Below are a couple of updates from the Finance Team.

- We are excited to announce that giving for our Making Room initiative has surpassed 50% of our \$1.4 million goal (actually 53%!!!). We are well on our way financially and believe that first demolition will be happening shortly!
- Along with summer, we again have the dog days of summer giving when many are at their cabins, at our children's sporting events and on long awaited summer vacations. Year to date congregation contributions are short about \$57,000 (5% of budget), which is a little further behind than usual at this time of year. Thankfully year-to-date operational expenses are slightly under what we budgeted at this point.

We give thanks for your generosity and diligence keeping those contributions coming so that we can most effectively Reach Out with a Voice of Hope throughout the summer and be on a firm foundation going into the fall. Thank you for all you have shared!
