BUILDING PROJECT UPDATE 7-30-26

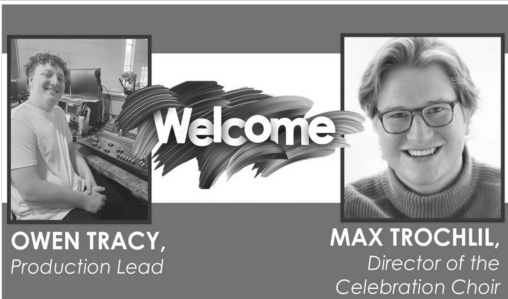
We are grateful for all the volunteers who were part of the demo phase of the project thus far. Over 228 volunteer hours have been contributed to the construction project already! Project action currently includes:

- Removing historical artifacts cabinets to prepare for kitchen serving window placement. Work has begun to reinstall the cabinets in the southwest hallway.
- Placing support beams to remove remaining load-bearing walls.
- Cement saw cutting will begin to bring water and sewer across hallway for kitchen and new ADA restroom.
