New Adult Education Opportunity: The Prayer Course

The Prayer Course is an eight-week, video-based group study designed to guide participants into a deeper, more authentic life of prayer. Rooted in the Lord's Prayer, each session will have a 20 min. video by Pete Greig, group discussion, and practical prayer experiences. The course is designed to be welcoming for people at every stage of faith. We will explore aspects of prayer while also creating space to wrestle with the reality of unanswered prayer within a supportive community. 
