Theme: Feel the Love

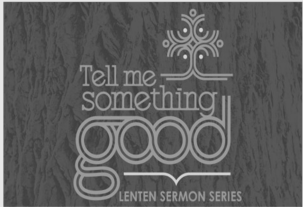

Sunday Sermon Series—Lent
In this series, we will ask: what are the core, foundational concepts of Jesus’ life and ministry? What makes each of these good news? Can we trust that the good news is truly good, even when it challenges us?

Following Jesus leads to a richer, more expansive life, but it’s not necessarily comfortable. We often describe Jesus’ ministry as “radical” which comes from the Latin word “radicalis,” meaning “root” or “ground.” Therefore, the good news should bring us back to our roots, back to what grounds us: loving our neighbor, caring for the vulnerable, pursuing justice and mercy, and resting in God’s unending grace. We hope this series will provide fertile ground for conversation and worship, rooting our hearts and lives in the expansive goodness of God.

- Mar. 1 – Great love for God & Neighbor

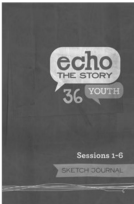
