- Develop communications plans to help grow membership and member relations
- Research and write articles for the USHCA website based on information from USHCA sources, including experts and webinars
- Help draft materials like newsletter, blogs, fact sheets and create video contents

Requirements

- Full-time undergraduate students or recent graduates
- Degree in communications, digital marketing, or public relations preferred
- Knowledge of and passion for improving U.S. China relations
- Eagerness to learn and ability to work efficiently and independently
- Strong communication & organizational skills
- Ability to manage own weekly work schedule to accommodate assignments and meet strict deadlines
- Social Media savvy and a good understanding of the use of visuals, particularly video
- Mandarin language skills preferred but not required
