The Tennis Center at Millersville Park

The Tennis Center at Millersville Park

The Tennis Alliance is working with Anne Arundel County Department of Recreation and Parks in a public/private venture to develop, operate and manage a Tennis Center at Millersville Park.

Timeline -- Project Milestones:

- January 2013 – Anne Arundel County Recreation and Parks 2013 Land Preservation Parks and Recreation Plan defines need for indoor tennis facilities.
- November 2013 – Millersville Site designated by County for Tennis Center.
- April 2014 – November 2016 – County Council approves study funding and Recreation and Parks conducts Feasibility Studies, Site Analysis, and Master Planning.
- June 2016 – County Council approves \$791K for Design funding in FY 2017.
- May 2017 – Letter of Intent memorializes public/private partnership.
- May 2017 – Notice to Proceed for A&E design and cost estimating issued.
- 2017 Draft Anne Arundel County Land Preservation Parks and Recreation Plan identifies the Millersville Park and Tennis Center as a short-range objective.
- FY2018 Recreation and Parks Capital Improvement Program budget projection for FY2019 is \$7.1 million subject to Administration and Council approval and an additional Tennis Alliance contribution of \$5 Million in private funds.
- Fall/Winter 2018 planned completion of Design; Bid/Award Construction to follow.

Plans for Tennis Center Facilities

Centrally located in the county, this facility will provide tennis players a state-of-the-art building with public access to clinics, programs and professional coaching.

Planned Facilities:

- 8 indoor & 12 outdoor lighted hard courts
- 4 outdoor lighted clay courts
- 2 multi-purpose courts to accommodate 10 & under
- Pro shop
- Lounge, locker rooms and fitness area
- Classrooms and meeting rooms
- Park amenities and spectator viewing area



Planned Programs and Activities

- Court times available for contract, drop-in and advanced reservation
- Outreach to community groups and employers
- USTA league play & tournaments
- High performance junior tennis training
- Full programming with tennis camps, parks, schools, ladders and social events
- Professional instruction for group lessons, clinics and private lessons
- Health and wellness programs

The Tennis Center will enhance the lives of Anne Arundel County residents, helping to make it a “great place to live and work.”

Anne Arundel is significantly underserved in access to indoor courts and programs compared to our neighboring counties.
