EASTER FLOWERS can be ordered, beginning next Sunday, to decorate our Sanctuary on Easter Sunday, in honor or memory of a loved one. If you are not a flower person, a donation can be made to SCAN (the food bank) instead. Orders need to be received by April 10th.

This year the Sunday School classes are participating in a Lenten Missions Project raising money to support Freedom Hill Horse Rescue. Freedom Hill Horse Rescue, located in Owings, works to save neglected, abused, and unwanted horses that are typically difficult to adopt. These horses are often older, have sustained injuries, or developed chronic disease. Our goal is to raise \$200 to purchase needed supplies (grooming tools - \$10 each, fly repellent, bait and traps - \$10-\$15 each, electrolyte supplement - \$11, cleaning supplies, feed supplement \$95, hoof hardener - \$40)!


Walking a labyrinth has much in common with the old 13th century practice of making a symbolic spiritual pilgrimage to Jerusalem. In this experience we are encouraged to leave behind our customary activities and preoccupations to cultivate a sense of expectancy, to be open to the possible transforming power of the "Holy". The labyrinth is an ancient tool for prayer and meditation, consisting of a winding path that begins at the periphery and leads to the center space and then out again by the same path.

This walk can bring blessings, repentance, and renewal back into our everyday lives. May your journey of faith be a pilgrimage rich in surprises drawing you ever near to Jesus Christ.
