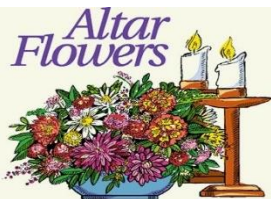
Please join us on *Sunday February 10th* at 12pm for our *Annual Birthday Party*
