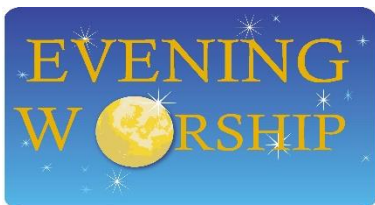

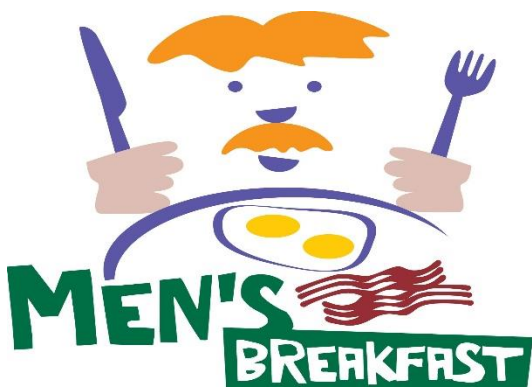
Sunday Evening Worship Services will be held at 7:00 pm on the following dates: TODAY, February 24, March 10 and 24, and April 7.

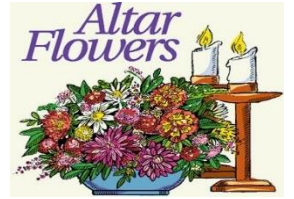
