

## SERVICE OF HOLY COMMUNION

L: All praise and all thanks belong to you, life-giving Lord. In the beginning your Spirit moved over the face of the waters, and when we were formed from the dust of the earth you breathed into us the breath of life. When we resisted and grieved you, your Spirit came upon prophets and teachers, anointing them to speak your word.

In the fullness of time you gave us your Son Jesus Christ, to be for us the way, the truth, and the life. At his baptism in the Jordan Your Spirit descended upon him and announced him as your beloved Son. With your Spirit upon him he turned away the temptation of sin; proclaimed justice to all peoples; and brought good news to the poor, release to the captives, sight to the blind, and freedom to the oppressed. He healed the sick, fed the hungry, ate with sinners, and won for you a new people by water and the Spirit.

Through his death and resurrection, you gave birth to your Church, delivered us from slavery to sin and death, and made with us a new covenant. At his ascension you exalted him to sit at your right hand, where according to his promise he is with us always, baptizing us with the Holy Spirit and with fire. Therefore, with your people in all ages and the whole company of heaven, we join in the song of unending praise:

**P: Holy, holy, holy Lord. God of power and might, heaven and earth are full of your glory. Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.**

L: On the night that he offered himself up for us, he took bread, gave thanks to you, broke the bread, gave it to his disciples, and said: "Take, eat; this is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

When the supper was over, he took the cup, gave thanks to you, gave it to his disciples, and said: "Drink from this, all of you; for this is my blood of the new covenant, poured out for you and for many, for the forgiveness of sins. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

On the day you raised him from the dead he was recognized by his disciples in the breaking of the bread, and in the power of your Holy Spirit your church has continued in the breaking of bread and the sharing of the cup.

Therefore, send the power of your Holy Spirit on us that, in the breaking of this bread and the drinking of this cup we may know the presence of the living Lord, be renewed as his body, and grow into his likeness.

**P: Through him, with him, in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours, Almighty God, now and forever. Amen.**
