Note: All donated laptops will have their hard drives removed and destroyed.

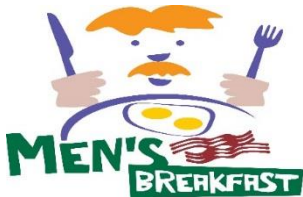

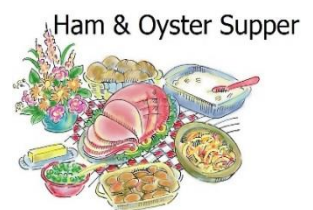
