POSITION DESCRIPTION: DIRECTOR OF CHILDREN AND YOUTH MINISTRIES

(30 hours weekly Exempt)

PURPOSE: To provide leadership and coordination for ministries involving the Christian education and spiritual formation of children and youth, to oversee a clear and consistent ministry.

ACCOUNTABILITY: Reports to and is supported by the Pastor/Head of Staff.

WORK WEEK: The position is 30 hours per week, including Sunday mornings and monthly evening meetings. THE DCYM will be on site as necessary and communicated to the congregation.

BENEFITS: Compensation shall include salary, study leave and vacation as negotiated and as confirmed in the letter of hire. Other benefits are according to the policies for full-time, professional exempt employes as set forth in the Personnel Policy Manual.

RESPONSIBILITIES: THE DCYM, under the direction of the Pastor/Head of Staff works with other staff and the congregation to achieve the mission and goals of Southminster Presbyterian Church. See the attached list of responsibilities for a detailed breakdown of current expectations for the position.

POSITIION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Has a strong commitment to Christ and to the Christian education and spiritual formation of children and youth.
- 2. Possesses a bachelors or graduate degree in education and experience related to children's education programming and working with children.
- 3. Exhibits solid interpersonal, planning teaching and mentoring skills.
- 4. Demonstrates the ability to work harmoniously and compassionately with all members of the congregation.
- 5. Can be decisive in crisis situations and is also flexible and of a collegial spirit.
- 6. Is committed to being present on Sunday mornings and other occasions when programs for children and youth are offered.
- 7. Computer literate and technology savvy.
- 8. Must be able to actively support Sunday morning worship and other special services related to the annual church calendar.
- 9. Appreciates diversity and fosters an inclusive community in the Church and beyond.

RELATIONSHIPS: The Director of Children and Youth Ministries is a member of the professional staff, is supervised by the Pastor/Head of Staff, and works with the pastoral staff, with the Christian Education Team with lay leaders and volunteers and with A Great Start Preschool. The Director of Children and Youth Ministries supervises the Child Care Staff.
