

Dear Public Official,

We are actively tracking Tropical Storm Henri that is predicted to bring severe weather to Northeast United States. The National Weather Service is predicting tropical storm force winds for eastern Long Island and southeast Connecticut. Tropical Storm Henri may cause power outages and network damage impacting internet, TV and phone service.

This week we have alerted our customers through email, social media, and text messages of the approaching storm and the potential for outages to their services. We have encouraged our customers who do not currently receive these alerts to sign up for service alerts via text or voice message by going to [My Account](#). Once confirmed, these customers will be notified when outages affect their service and will receive timely updates until their service is restored.
