Camp rates will be counted by the last piece of information received for each camper. If paperwork is not submitted by early bird (\$230) pricing due date (June 15th), the camper will be paying full price (\$250). **All registration fees must be received by July 17th. Camp money is non-refundable but can be transferred to another camper or adult.** Please **DO NOT** mail camp money or forms to the District Office or the Campground.

**Please label all items with your child's name to help prevent loss.**

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING:** Money, Electronics, Phones, Fireworks, Pocket Knives

**BEHAVIOR STANDARD:** Parents, please encourage your child to respect adults and follow all camp rules while they are away from you. The purpose of this camp is to share God's love with children and create memories that will last a lifetime. Disrespectful language and behaviors such as fighting, profane language or destruction of property will not be tolerated. Campers will be given warnings before being sent home at the expense of the parent.

**MEDICATION:** Please put all medicines in a clear baggie with your child's name. Write on a 3x5 card your child's name, name of meds, dosage schedule and any special instructions. All meds will be turned in to the camp nurse upon arrival. Over-the-counter medications are available through the nurse. No need to send these.

**LICE CHECKS:** Every Camper and Staff Volunteer **MUST** be lice checked before they can stay at camp. Please check **BEFORE** you leave for camp to help us with this issue. No refunds will be given in the case of lice.
